

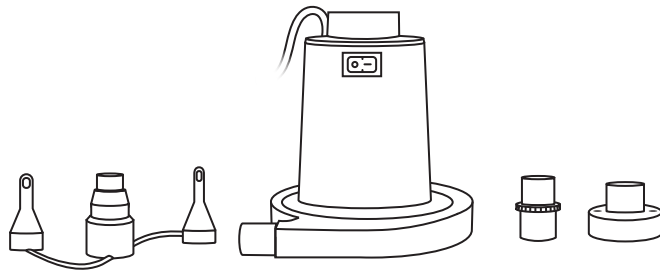

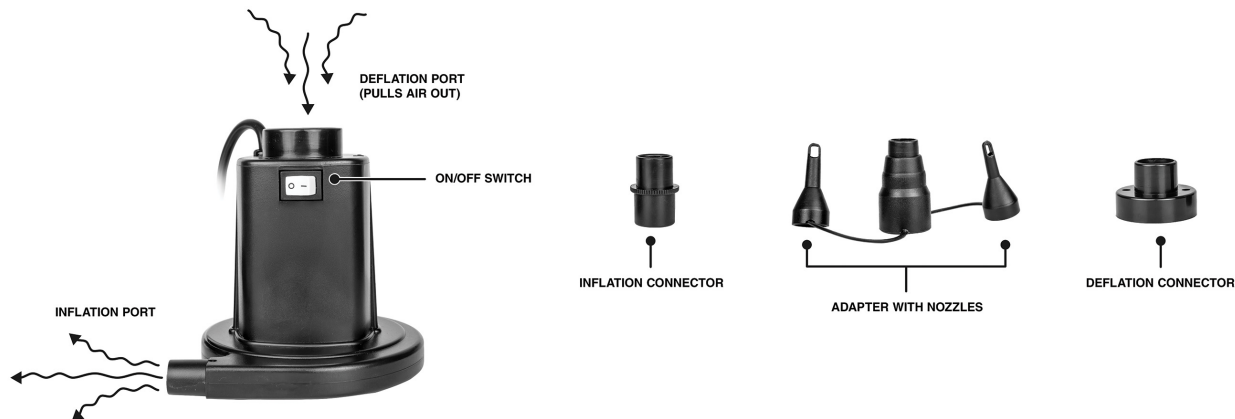

## Important

### Read Before Use

- This handheld air pump is for use on a nominal 120-volt AC circuit with grounded outlet
- This is a high-volume, low-pressure pump. It is intended to inflate/deflate items such as inflatable boats, air mattresses, etc. This pump is not designed for continuous use. Extended operation over 30 min can overheat and damage the pump.
- Keep air pump out of reach of children.
- Do not obstruct the inflation/deflation port and keep them ventilated at all times.
- To shorten the motor's working time and faster inflation, always use the most suitable adapter/nozzle for your inflatable valve size.

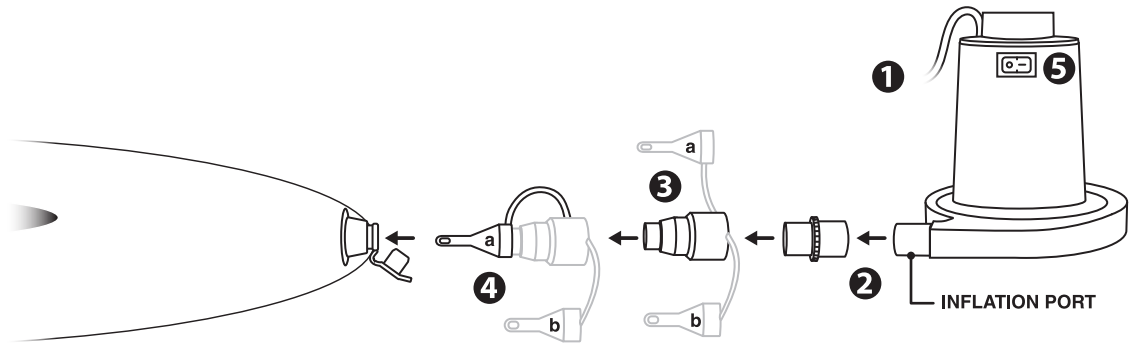
## Warning

- Improper installation of the grounding plug can result in a risk of electric shock... Make sure the pump is connected to a grounding outlet protected by a ground-fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not connect unit to an extension cord.
- Check with a qualified electrician if the grounding instructions are not completely understood, or if in doubt whether the product is properly grounded.
- Carefully follow the instructions on inflatable item when inflating. Never exceed the recommended pressure, otherwise serious injury may be caused if inflatable bursts.
- Never leave the pump unattended while the pump is in use.
- Do not keep/use the pump in wet conditions.
- Never allow sand, small rocks, etc to be sucked into inflation/deflation port when using pump.
- Never look inside or point the inflation/deflation port toward your eyes when the pump is working.
- Never attempt to put hand or fingers into the inflation/deflation port at any time.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock and injury to persons, do not use in a window.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not use this fan with any solid-state speed control device.
- Do not use this pump as a hair dryer. Keep hair away from the inflation port while pump is in use.

## TO INFLATE

1. Plug in pump.
2. Insert inflation connector to inflation port.
3. Insert adapter with nozzles.
4. Choose selected nozzle (a or b) for inflation or for larger valve openings, use with adapter only.
5. Turn on unit to inflate.
6. The valve of inflatable item should not be obstructed, otherwise it could over heat and damage the pump.
7. Never use the deflation vent when inflating an item. On large items such as an inflatable boat or king-size air mattress, the pump should fit directly onto the valve of inflatable item for fast inflation. Use appropriate adapter for smaller valves on items like as single-size air mattress.

**NOTE:** For smaller valves, you may have to pinch valve base to open up safety valve.

## TO DEFLATE

1. Plug in pump.
2. Insert deflation connector onto deflation port.
3. Insert adapter with nozzles.
4. Choose selected nozzle (a or b) for deflation.
5. Turn on unit to deflate.

**NOTE:** For smaller valves, you may have to pinch valve base to open up safety valve.
