

ASSEMBLY FOR JET OPERATION (FIGURE 1)

1. Attach garden hose connector to Jet Vac
2. Attach garden hose to the hose connector – hose not included
3. Attach vacuum bag to the top of the vacuum body just under the rim. Press and slide cord lock into place to tighten
4. Choose your pole preference options below (Fig. 4 or Fig. 5)
5. Turn on water to garden hose to initiate suction



ASSEMBLY FOR THRU-FILTER OPERATION (IF USING WITH A VACUUM HOSE) (FIGURE 2)

1. Attach vacuum hose adapter to the top of the vacuum body – will accommodate a 1 ¼" to 1 ½" hose – sold separately
2. Attach your vacuum hose over the adapter and push firmly into place
3. Choose your pole preference options below (Fig. 4 or Fig. 5)
4. Prime the hose by placing the vacuum and hose into the pool allowing the hose to completely fill with water

PRIMING TIP: You can use a garden hose to fill the vacuum hose or place the free end of the vacuum hose into the return line of the pool which will push water into the hose

5. Connect the water-filled hose to your skimmer or suction part of the pool (Fig. 3)



IF USING THE 6-PIECE POLE SET (FIGURE 4)

1. Assemble pole by connecting sections together and insert into the pole port by threading into place – NOTE: The spring clip must be removed from the pole port if it is not already.

IF USING A STANDARD 1 ¼" POOL POLE (FIGURE 5)

1. Insert the included spring clip into the pole port making sure the ends are seen through the pole port
2. Slide the pole over the pole port and make sure the ends of the spring clip are aligned with the holes on the pole – spring clip ends should be seen on the outside of the pole

CARE/STORAGE:

When not in use, your Jet Vacuum should be rinsed with tap water and stored where it is protected from the sunlight. The brushes should be stored with the bristles up to keep them straight.
